To him that excels living in God's heart. A Psalm of David, the servant of the Lord.

- 1 Evil leads the wicked man to greater evils to try to hide his wickedness, having no fear of God before his eyes engulfed in pride and power and selfishness..
- 2 For he flatters himself in his own eyes, not seeing his iniquity, that all others see and detest.
- 3 The words of his mouth are iniquity and deceit: he has abandoned doing good and loving others.
- 4 He thinks and imagines constantly at night, of how to hurt others: he chooses a path that is not good, and does not abhor evil, that is destructive and leads to hell.
- 5 But for you, who trust in my love for you, my mercy reaches unto the heavens, and my faithfulness to you reaches into the clouds.
- 6 My all knowing and all powerful love, is like the mighty mountains: my judgments are like a great ocean that saves man and beast.
- 7 My excellent mercies are limitless, my heart's wings spread across the heavens, under which you can trust.
- 8 You, my child shall be satisfied with the wealth of blessings of your house, and you may drink freely out of the river of my living waters of merciful joyful pleasures in blessing you.
- 9 I your loving Father, Savior and Holy Spirit am the well of all life, and in my light, you shall see the light for your own life.
- 10 Know my love, and then trust my love, and see my all powerful loving kindness and mercies growing in your heart, and see my righteousness of gracious, kindness, and charity, living in your heart.

- 11 My love for you is an impregnable wall, where others' satanic pride will not harm your soul, and the hand of the wicked will not undermine your trust in my love for you.
- 12 The wicked who have no trust in my love, and do not fear me, shall fall and be cast down and shall not be able to rise.
